

Loving, Following, and Serving through Scripture

Discipleship is helping people love, follow, and serve Jesus with all of themselves. It is the act of obeying Jesus' Great Commission to multiply His Kingdom by making disciples and helping them observe all that He commanded us (Matthew 28:18-20). But it's not just about what we do (Great Commission). It's also how we do it (Great Commandment). In His kindness, God has given us a framework to "apply," ensuring that we don't fall victim to the task of discipleship, but that in every aspect of our life we love the Lord with all our heart, soul, mind, and strength (Mark 12:30). Whether we've loved the Lord for two days or twenty years, we all have an opportunity to be discipled and disciple others.
