# **2022 SERVE AUSTIN FOCUS**

#### SEND - IMPACTING THE WORLD Focus on Serving

Last fall, during our Generous Worship sermon series, many of you generously gave above and beyond to our Vision Fund. These special funds would be used in varying percentages toward church planting, a gathering space, serving Austin, and our Residency Program. For 2022, we'll be working with our CGs to focus mostly on serving the city through food pantries, schools, ministry to the homeless, refugees, and foster care families! #### Fostering a Heart for Others

We have loved seeing our church Body step up with a passion for foster care ministry. We currently have 15 kids being served within 14 licensed homes at The Well (8 of those being single parents). We have 72 supporters at The Well who help these families with groceries, babysitting, or errands. Recently, there was a child reunified with her birth mom and our supporters rallied around them to help during the transition. Because of the relationship that was built, the birth mom has even started attending church on Sundays! Let's rejoice at what the Lord is doing through us to serve these kids and their parents!

#### On Mission in the Middle East

At the end of November, we sent out a short-term mission team to the Middle East and they saw the Lord do some incredible things! They were able to prayer walk the city, lifting up the locals who don't know God and asking for open doors for our ministry partners in-country. They visited refugee families, bringing gifts, food, and medicine. They got to share the gospel and saw a handful of people come to faith! They also baptized two of our team members, Hayley and Michael, in the same place Jesus was baptized! So cool!

# FINANCIAL UPDATE

Wow-our church year is moving by quickly! We are at the mid-way point of our 21-22 fiscal year and looking forward to what God has planned for us as we move into the next quarter. God continues the bless The Well in so many ways and we see this so clearly with our finances.

From your generosity and trust in God's provision, we received \$565,866 to the General Fund (forecast giving was estimated at \$498,795). This represents an 8.5% increase over the prior quarter actual and a 13% increase over estimated giving. God is good – all the time!

On the expense side, personnel and ministry costs came in below estimates, resulting in actual costs at \$409,769 vs. a budget of \$493,178. Your generosity has continued to allow us to support Covenant Members in need as well as others connecting to the church for financial help through our Benevolence Fund. In addition, with our year-end giving focus, the Vision Fund closed at \$392,174 in total giving! We will now be able to allocate \$157,000 to a gathering location, \$78,434 to Church Planting (domestically and internationally), \$98,043 to our minority Residency Program, and \$58,826 to serving Austin. As Tory shared during our last Celebration Sunday in March, we have started the process of distributing these funds to focus on supporting food banks, refugee services, homeless ministries, and schools in Austin as well as setting aside up to \$500 for every CG to support their own serving plan.

With total income continuing to exceed expenses, our unrestricted reserves now total \$1.08 MM. When combined with the gathering porting from the Vision Fund as well as the money in the Acceleration fund, we have a total of \$1.24 MM that can be used immediately (if needed) to help secure a permanent gathering location!

At the mid-year mark, we continue the financial trend from the first quarter and look forward to the kingdom work that God has planned for us in the next quarter. We are so appreciative of your prayers and continued partnership as we push back darkness in Austin and around the world.
