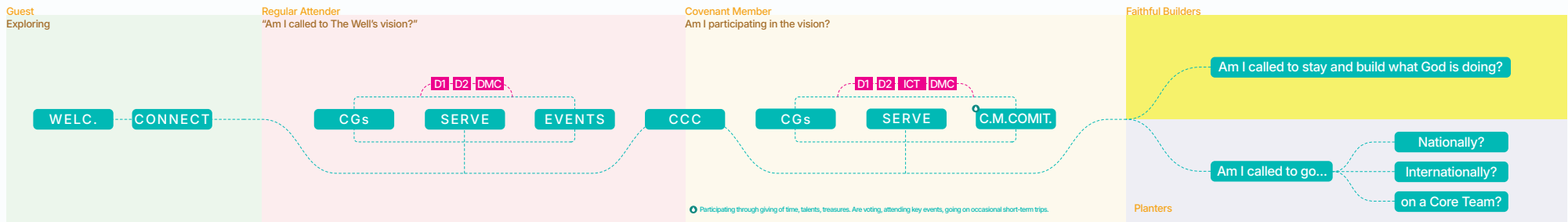


Discipleship Journey Pipeline

Acronyms Breakdown

D1: Becoming like Jesus: A discipleship Journey. Forms disciples by anchoring them in the life and ministry of Jesus, helping participants encounter Him in the Gospels and shape their lives around His teaching, character, and call to follow Him.

D2: Maturing in Jesus: A discipleship journey. Develops gospel literacy and application by helping participants understand how the message of the gospel unfolds across Scripture and how it shapes faith, obedience, and discipleship.

DMC: Discipleship Making Cohort. This is a 10-week Disciple Making Cohort that brings together groups of 6–12 people who want to learn how to share their faith, walk with others spiritually, and grow in their own relationship with Jesus. Together you'll build habits that shape everyday life—spending time with God, learning practical tools for spiritual conversations, and stepping into meaningful opportunities to love neighbors both here in Austin and around the world.

ICT: International Core Team Training. International Core Team Training (ICT) is a 30-week immersive program designed to prepare you for long-term cross-cultural ministry. Participants live in community, follow a shared weekly rhythm, and practice real-world outreach in Austin. You'll grow in character, learn to build healthy teams, navigate conflict, make disciples, and develop a clear ministry plan. This training runs from mid-August through April with built-in breaks and a sustainable pace. ICTT is intentional and selective, helping you discern whether this is the right next step for your season and calling.
